## Rear Brake Tip Kit on OEM Lever Arm Instructions:

The Hammerhead Brake Tip is supplied ready to be installed on the stock lever arm. If these instructions are not precisely followed, you may permanently damage your OEM Brake lever.

Step 1: Remove the stock brake arm carefully so as to not lose the connecting bolt or any stock mud seals or gaskets. *Step 2:* Use a vice to hold brake lever arm. Use the hole

in the brake tip rivet as a guide to center your drill. Carefully drill out & remove the stock rivet the holds the stock brake tip to the lever arm. (Only drill or cut deep enough to allow the rivet to be removed.) Step 3: Remove stock brake tip. Install Hammerhead Brake Tip using the 10mm Nylon Lock Nut. Be sure to use medium strength threadlock and tighten firmly.





### **Rear Brake Kit Instructions:**

Step 1: If you are installing a Hammerhead Rear Brake Kit check to see if you need to re-use the stock mud seals. Hammerhead supplies these seals for some models, and for others it is necessary to re-use the stock seals. For the 02-05 CRF450 and all YZF450 Brake Pedal Kits it is necessary to use a spacer washer for proper fit. The spacer should be placed on the inside for the CRF and on the outside for the YZF. **Brake Snake Instructions:** 

can be connected either through The Hammerhead Brake snake the Brake Tip or the small hole on the botton side of the Brake Arm. Loop the free end of the wire around a part of the frame just in front of the end of the brake and tighten just enough such that the brake pedal can still move freely up and down and then crimp. Trim excess material.
